Reinstatement (\$25 full or \$20 Social/Jr.) does not include a T-shirt and other benefits

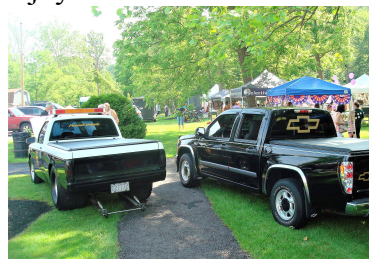

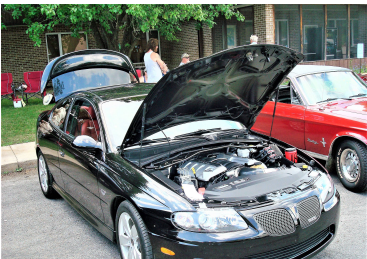
Locust Grove Cruise-in/car Show

Shermansdale Cruise-in:

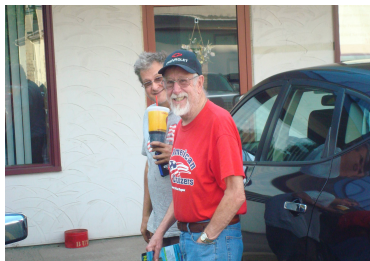
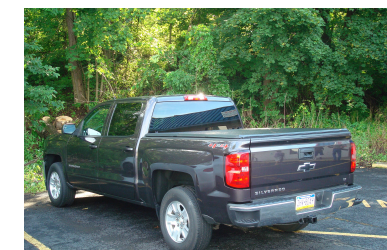

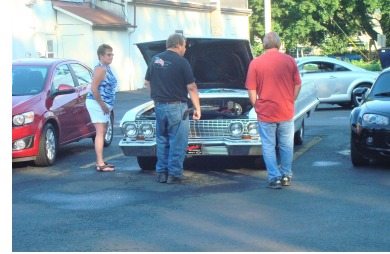
